

# What you need to know about running for Council

# 1. Roles of Mayor and Councillor

- Town of Picture Butte Council is made up of a Mayor and four (4) Councillors.
- The position of Mayor is by election.
- Each year at the Organizational meeting held in October, a Deputy Mayor is elected by members of Council for a term of one year.

### 2. Time Commitment

- Council Meetings are held the second and fourth Monday of each month starting at 6:30 p.m.
- Committee of the Whole Meeting is held the third Monday of the month starting at 6:30 p.m.
- Council Committee meetings are appointed yearly during the Organizational meeting in October.
- Newly elected officials are mandated to take Elected Official Training within 90 days of taking oath of office.
- Alberta Municipalities holds an annual convention in the Fall of every year for elected officials.

# 3. Eligibility Requirements

To be an eligible candidate, you must:

- Be a Canadian Citizen and 18 years of age.
- Must have resided in the Town of Picture Butte for six (6) consecutive months before the Nomination Day.
- Are not otherwise ineligible or disqualified.

You are NOT eligible under any of these circumstances:

- You are an auditor of the Town of Picture Butte.
- You are an employee of the Town of the Picture Butte.
- Your property taxes are more than \$50 in arrears or you are in default for more than 90 days on any other debt in excess of \$500.
- You have in the previous ten years been convicted under the LAEA, EA or CEA.

# 4. How Council is Governed

The Province of Alberta provides the structure for local governments through legislation known as the Municipal Government Act (MGA).

#### Some important tips to remember:

- All decisions must be made at public meetings with a quorum of Council present.
- Individual members of Council do NOT have the power to commit the municipality to any expenditure, or to direct the activities of municipal employees.
- The expenditure of funds or direction of employees may only be carried out by passing a resolution of Council.
- Any promise you make as part of your election campaign can only be fulfilled if a majority of Council votes in favor of the matter.

#### 5. Nomination Period & Contributions

#### Nomination Period is January 2, 2025 to September 22, 2025 at 12:00 p.m. at Picture Butte Town Office

- Nomination forms will not be accepted prior to or following this time period.
- Campaign contributions by any person, corporation, trade union, or employee organization to a candidate shall not exceed \$5,000 in any year.
  Money paid by a candidate out of the candidate's own funds shall not exceed \$10,000.
